POSITIVE PRESSURE

Flush Technique for the CLAVE® Connector

It is recommended to positive pressure flush the CLAVE Connector to prevent the backflow of blood into the catheter upon disconnection.

DIRECTIONS FOR FLUSHING:

- 1. Flush CLAVE Connector as normally prescribed after each use per facility protocol. Use about 1cc of the flush solution to conduct the positive pressure flush.
- 2. Without disconnecting flush syringe, grasp syringe barrel firmly with thumb and fingers and position index finger on top of syringe plunger.
- **3.** While disconnecting syringe allow index finger to rest firmly on plunger in order to push the remaining 1cc of flush from syringe.
- **4.** This procedure will allow you to completely fill the catheter, and prevent the backflow of blood into the catheter lumen upon disconnection.



- Do Not Use Needles.
- Flush CLAVE after each use per facility protocol.
